Investors purchase shares in PEC Renewables.

Investors become Members of PEC Renewables and earn a target of 6% interest per year.



PEC Renewables provides a loan to Ernesettle Community Solar.

Surplus funds from Ernesettle Community Solar are used by Plymouth **Energy Community to fight fuel poverty** and climate change around Plymouth.

Ernesettle Community Solar owns and manages the array.

Ernesettle Community Solar earns an income from subsidies and electricity sales.

Four Greens Community Trust earn a rental income, supporting community activities in the surrounding four neighbourhoods.


